




Jim Pollard

Jim Pollard grew up in Rankin, Texas, a small town in the middle of the Permian Basin. Jim went to Southwest Texas State College in San Marcus, TX and graduated in 1965 and became a shop teacher.

Jim now resides in New Mexico and will turn 76 years old this shooting experience on-line at



1997. At that time, matches were held at your local range and your scores were submitted through the website through an honor system. At one time he says there were over 100 participants in this on-line game.

After his on-line experience, he began shooting IR 50/50 in Gatesville, Texas with fellow shooters Billy Russell and Fred Gould.

Jim now is a very active rimfire benchrest shooter at the Zia Rifle and Pistol Club in Albuquerque, New Mexico as well as San Juan Wildlife Federation in Farmington, New Mexico. Jim plans on competing at the ARA Outdoor Nationals in St. Louis again this year as well.

Jim says the best part of his shooting experience has been meeting and making friends with many people over the years, like Johnny Montgomery, Jay Sullivan, Kurt Palmer, David III and Ed Shillen to name a few.

ELEY Establishes the Lones Wigger Award

In the field of shooting, "leaend" could be replaced with a name and that name would be Lones Wigger. Wigger is the most decorated



shooter of all time and his impact on the sport and shooters alike has never been equaled. On December 14, 2017, the shooting world had to say goodbye to their legend, as after a two-year battle with pancreatic cancer, Wigger passed away.

A five time Olympian and a retired Lieutenant Colonel of the Army, Lones Wigger is the only USA Shooting athlete in the U.S. Olympic Committee's Hall of Fame. He has won 111 international medals, more than any shooter in the world. In 1996 and 2002 he carried the Olympic Torch and was selected as one of the U.S. Olympic Committee's 100 Golden Olympians. Lones was a fierce competitor and continued to gain accomplishments throughout his shooting career, which spanned well into his late 70s.

USA Shooting and the Wigger family held a memorial for Lones on February 24 at the USA Shooting range that was recently dedicated in his name. Wig's presence will be missed on the ranges around the country, but his legacy will

KNOW THE RULES!

ARA Competitor numbers are very important. Your scores at every event you attend are tied to your number. Know your number and make sure the match director at each event uses the correct number when they send in scores to the ARA office for posting. Of course, if you notice a posting mistake on the ARA website, notify the ARA office immediately for correction.

9.3 Sign in Sheets, Competitor Number, and New Competitor

9.3.1 Each competitor needs to accurately complete the Sign-In Sheet, including the last four digits of his/ her Social Security Number, plus the initials of his/her name. (Example 1234MGL). This number becomes his/her official ARA statistical number, which is needed for maintenance of all statistical computer database records.

9.3.2 It is imperative that competitors sign-in consistently with the same numbers and initials each time or face the possibility that their scores may be improperly entered into the ARA database. If a competitor is new to a range, please check the competitor's ARA ID card to ensure the proper name and ARA number is used. 9.3.3 If a competitor has never competed in an ARA event, the match director shall have the new competitor fill out the "New Competitor" form and the match director will return that to the ARA business office.
