The only place he has not competed is the Northeast. Joe's wife, Mary, has always wanted to see the Fall foliage in the Northeast. So; now that he is semi-retired, he's thinking of making a run for some of the Fall matches in that beautiful area.

Joe enjoys all the camaraderie between rimfire benchrest shooters. He particularly loves shooting at the ARA National Tournament, because as he says, "It's like a big reunion".

Joe describes the precision of the sport, "like a finely tuned pocket watch that neither gains or loses a second a month - when you find that right barrel/ammo combination".

When asked who comes to mind when he thinks back on how he began as a serious competitive shooter, Joe replies, "Glen Townley and Bobby Love". Back in the beginning of BR50, everyone wanted to shoot as good as Glen. Glen freely gave Joe advice on tuning his Anschutz that Joe says he would have never thought of on his own. Bobby was his first gunsmith and holds numerous world records in centerfire shooting. His advice on setting up his rest and guns have proven invaluable to Joe over the years.

One of Joe's most significant accomplishments was achieving 500 Hall of Fame points and being acknowledged by the shooting community. His personalized "Red Shoes" trophy was one of the biggest and best surprises he has ever received. Another important accomplishment has been seeing someone that he coached and mentored, Maddi Reed, become a better shooter than him.

Joe's hobby of making stained glass windows turned into his full-time business. He enjoys the creative aspect which allows him to relax. Many of his favorite times have been in his studio with the music cranked up, working on a window. Joe also collects pocket watches, which, like shooting, have a precision aspect that he finds fascinating. Joe's collection includes pocket watches still running good that date back to the 1700's. He hopes his Anschutz rifles will last as long those 250 year old watches.

Even though he's having fun while shooting, Joe always plays to win. "The drive home is much more enjoyable when I win."


